Mega E began about four years ago after an out pouring of the Holy Spirit, after months of prayer and seeking the lord.

The Holy Spirit fell on us one night during prayer. The Lord later spoke to me and said "Put My Spirit on them". He was asking me to put His Spirit on all the wild youth hanging around outside the building and on the street where we met.

So, with some reluctance and uncertainty I told one of the youth that God wanted to put His Spirit on him. Surprised, he said "Okay" and ran off to get his mates to come also.

When 7 of them arrived we laid hands on the biggest guy and asked Jesus to send the Holy Spirit on him. The power of God hit him and he staggered around like a drunk man. The next boy said "Pray for me!". We did and the power of God was so strong he was knocked to the ground

on his back and instantly shot straight back on his feet like he had landed on a trampoline.

I preached the Gospel to all the boys and they all received Jesus as their Lord. The power of God had revealed the truth of God to them - He was real and Jesus was real.



The Lord spoke to me again and said "Go to Terrigal". So after about a month of the Spirit's power coming on the youth at Bateau Bay and youth getting saved, we went to Terrigal.

Well, the Holy Spirit did extra ordinary things. I would preach the Gospel and pray for those who responded and people got healed, people got delivered of addictions.

People got saved from all over Australia and even some from overseas out here on holidays.

Then the Lord sent me to skate parks on the Coast to preach the gospel. The youth came - as many as thirty at a time - to receive Christ.

Holy Spirit came with such power and manifestation of His presence they would shake, fall down or cry out. This would draw a bigger crowd who, when seeing the power of God and hearing the Gospel, would want to receive Christ also.

We have had about 1600 people, mainly youth, receive Christ and encounter the power and presence of Holy Spirit at conversion.

When Your Marriage Needs Help!

Every marriage experiences problems. No matter how long you have been married – whether one year or 40 years – you will have problems. Marital problems can be extremely intense and painful, and those hurts can cut deeply and last a very long time.

The pain caused by someone you care about as much as your spouse may be very difficult to deal with. Most of us have preconceived ideas about how our spouses should treat us. We expect mistreatment from other people, but not from our spouses.

Just remember that as human beings, we often think, feel and behave in ways that are hurtful, even toward those we love. Flawed people treat each other in flawed ways; so no matter how much we care, we'll sometimes hurt each other.

Your marriage isn't doomed because you hurt one another, have difficulty communicating or have disagreements over important issues.

Couples have been experiencing and solving problems on

their own beginning with Adam and Eve, and continuing to this day. The more experience and maturity a couple develops in a marriage, the more success gained in managing and solving problems. God created us with the ability to successfully manage relationships in a healthy and productive way.

Ask other couples what it took to build a strong and successful marriage. Rest assured that their strong marriages did not develop overnight. They experienced some of the same problems you have.

One reason their marriages are strong today is that they were committed to the idea that no matter what obstacles they faced, they would learn to manage their problems and overcome crisis on an ongoing basis.

Please understand that the principles we're suggesting are not intended to deal with every problem that couples deal with in marriage.

We especially don't want to imply that you should remain in a situation where your safety or the safety of your family is at

risk. If you are in a relationship where your spouse displays any of the following signs, please seek help immediately:

- Physically abusive
- Displays symptoms of a significant mental illness
- Has a major chemical imbalance
- Threatens the safety of you or your children

These are not simplistic issues and cannot be dealt with by simply reading a book or talking to a friend. Seek professional help immediately.

You can call your local mental health hotline, or contact Focus on the Family Australia on 1300 300 361 to guide you to a Christian psychologist or psychiatrist in your specific area.
